I can't even tell you how many people ask me about when to stop watering their gardens this time of year. Here's the deal . . . keep watering until the temperature falls consistently below 32 degrees. You can ease up watering but do not put that hose away just yet. A couple weeks ago was a perfect example of our crazy weather and why plants can really take a hit this time of year. We had low temps in the 30's but no rain. Plants need about 1-2" of water a week. If you haven't watered your garden you should.

I only ask for one good soaking a week (unless your plants were very recently installed then follow my specific directions).

It's not good for your plants to go into winter thirsty.
